THE EFFECT OF TEMPERATURE ON THE RATE OF REACTION

Reaction: $2H_2O_2 \rightarrow 2H_2O + O_2$




Fig. 1. The effect of temperature on the rate of reaction. (Left) at 20°C, (right) at 40°C.

1. The rate of reaction was measured by the volume of oxygen gas evolved over a period of 10 minutes. The reaction was carried out at two different temperatures, 20°C and 40°C. The results are shown in the table below.

Temperature (°C)	Volume of O_2 evolved (cm ³)
20	10
40	20
