RESULTS

The results of the descriptive analysis are presented in Table 1. The prevalence of COPD was 10.1% (95% CI 9.4–10.8%) and the prevalence of asthma was 10.1% (95% CI 9.4–10.8%). The prevalence of COPD was significantly higher in the low SES group (12.1%) than in the middle (8.1%) and high (7.1%) SES groups.
